Day 10 Sunday May 20th (B)

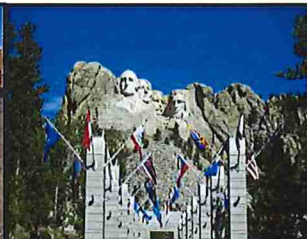
We depart Colorado today making our way to Nebraska for our last overnight stay.
