#### DAY 1 TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 3

Depart via Delta Airlines for Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada. Transfer to our downtown hotel.

#### DAY 2 WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 4 (B)

Depart Vancouver for a full day tour of Victoria, the capital city of British Columbia. Begin with a 90 minute cruise on BC Ferries across the Strait of Georgia and through the Picturesque Gulf Islands. Arriving in Swartz Bay, continue to the world-renowned Butchart Gardens, which has 50 acres of magnificent color and floral arrangements. Spent time to explore on your own. We continue to downtown Victoria. Highlights include the Inner Harbor, Beacon Hill Park, the Parliament Buildings and the Empress Hotel. You will have free time to explore Victoria's Inner Harbor for shopping. Late afternoon re-board our motor coach which will return us to Swartz Bay for the 5:00 pm ferry ride back to Vancouver.

## DAY 3 THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 5 (L)

Today, we will explore Vancouver's sights, sounds and spectacular scenery. This tour will take you through Gastown and North America's second largest Chinatown. Visit the world famous 1,000 acre Stanley Park and stop at the Totem Poles and Prospect point, which offer a spectacular view of Lions Gate Bridge. We will have an included lunch at Dockside Restaurant and Brewing Company. Spend the balance of the day exploring Vancouver on your own.

#### DAY 4 FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 6 (B,L)

This morning we will transfer to the rail station and board "The Most Spectacular Train Trip in the World", the Rocky Mountaineer. Cooked to order breakfast and lunch will be served onboard the train in GoldLeaf Service. A Hot entrée served in SilverLeaf Service. We will travel through the Pacific Coastal Mountain Range and Meander along the natural path of the Thompson River and travel along the impressive Fraser Canyon. We will stop for the night in Kamloops, gateway to British Columbia's interior.

## DAY 5 SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 7 (B, L)

Today we will wind through the vast ranchlands and along Shuswap Lake as we depart Kamloops. Again breakfast and lunch are included on the train. Next you will see Craigellachie, where the "last spike" was driven completing the Canadian Pacific Railway in 1885. We will see Rogers Pass with its awe inspiring glistening glaciers, snowcapped mountains and tunnels as we cross the Continental Divide departing British Columbia. En route we will travel through Yoho National Park, where the train will pass through the unique Spiral Tunnels, a remarkable engineering achievement. We have been traveling on the Kicking Horse Route to Banff, an alpine community nestled in the Rocky Mountains, a world famous resort. Tall peaks, wooded valleys, crystal-clear waters and canyons are all preserved in natural magnificence.

#### DAY 6 SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 8 (B. L)

A wonderful day of sightseeing is in store for you today. We will visit beautiful Moraine Lake and the Valley of the Ten Peaks. Lunch at the Lake Louise ski area. Continue to Yoho National Park and the beautiful area of Takakkaw Falls, the 3rd highest falls in North America. Relax this evening at our hotel in the heart of Banff.

## DAY 7 MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 9 (B)

Today we motor up the Icefields Parkway, considered one of the most scenic highways in the world. Not a minute passes where snow-domed peaks, waterfalls, lakes or wildlife don't compete for your attention. A few sights today will be Castle Mountain, Bow Lake, Peyto Lake and Sunwapta Pass. One of the many highlights of this trip will be to ride a mammoth Snocoach onto the Columbia Icefield. Step onto ice formed from snow which fell as long as 400 years ago. Return to Banff arriving late afternoon.

## DAY 8 TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 10 (B)

As we depart Banff today, we will tour lovely Bow Falls, Cascade Park, then ride the Sulfer Mountain Gondola for an unobstructed 360 degree view of the Banff town site.

We continue on to Calgary, site of the famous Calgary Stampede. We will tour Olympic Park, the site of the 1988 Winter Olympics.
